  - NCSC will accept ACCUPLACER and ACT

# Test Scores for Ohio's CCP Eligibility

Ohio's CCP Eligibility Requirement is **met with qualifying scores from at least one subtest.**

Exam	Subtest	Eligible Score	Conditional Range* (*Requires 3.0 GPA or District Recommendation)
<i>ACT</i>	Reading	22	20-21
	English	18	16-17
	Math	22	20-21
<i>ACCUPLACER</i> (NextGen)	Reading	250	243-249
	English (WritePlacer)	5	4
	Advanced Algebra	263	257-262

\*Some Level I courses require placement by *higher* scores, or a course prerequisite.

\*\*If Ohio extends the GPA option beyond Fall 2020, then so too will NCSC.

# Tuition Freedom Scholarship (TFS)

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**An opportunity to study -- *tuition free* -- at NCSC after high school!**

Recipients of the Tuition Freedom Scholarship (TFS) will be awarded up to an associate degree, or a maximum of 64 credit hours at NCSC, tuition free.

- TFS applies to tuition only. It will *not* cover fees or textbooks.
- TFS *can be combined* with other NCSC scholarships.
- NCSC credits earned in high school will be deducted from the scholarship's 64 hour cap.

# Tuition Freedom Scholarship (TFS)

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## How to qualify for TFS:

- Complete 8-9 college credit hours with NCSC while in CCP or a partnering Career Tech program\*
- Earn a minimum 2.75 Grade Point Average for both high school and college
- Apply for the TFS scholarship during Senior year. Complete required items by the deadlines

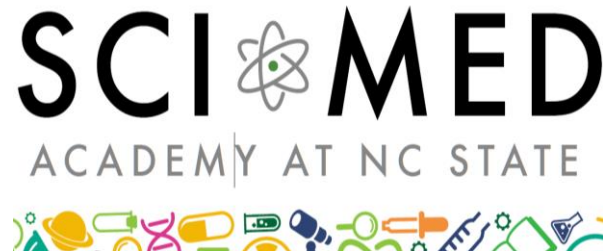
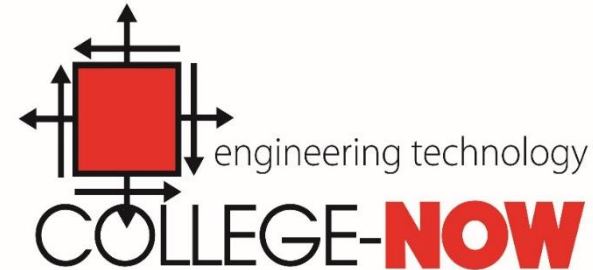
\*Direct Admission into a Health Sciences program will require 9 hours for TFS



# College-Now & Sci-Med Academy

## Earn your Associate degree while in high school

- Students attend the college full-time in the Junior and Senior year of high school
- Admission criteria differs by degree program
- Requires early planning in 9<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> grade



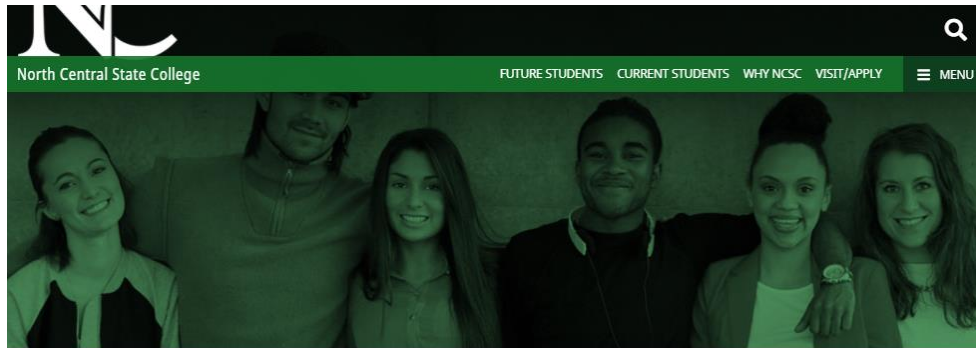
