Participants will learn:

- the principles & research base for structured teaching.
- how to apply structured teaching principles to support students of varying ages & ability levels.
- how to implement structured teaching in a variety of settings including special education classrooms, general education classrooms, & the community.
- how to teach students to use structured teaching components.
- how to “re-structure” systems when students are not responding positively.
